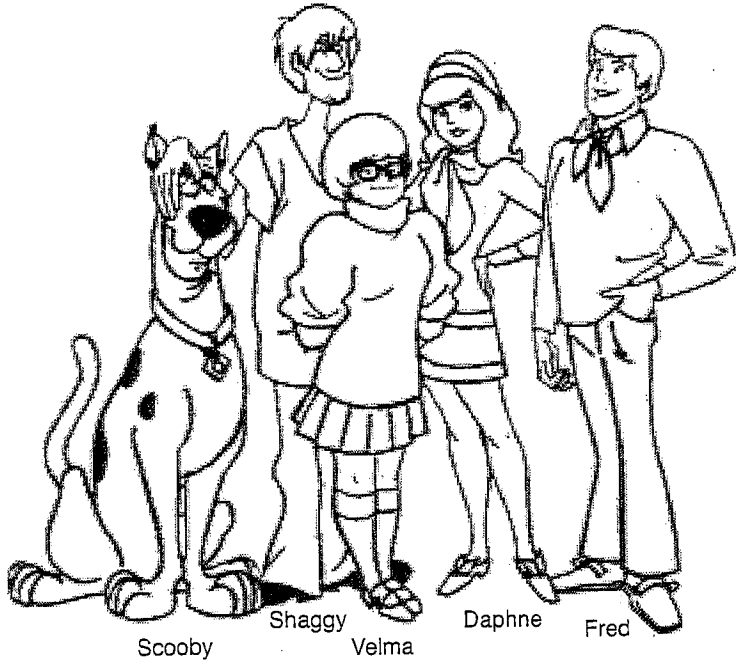


## Color Review

Use the rules given for each picture to correctly color them. Some of the colors might not be the ones you're used to for familiar objects!

USE **ADDITIVE** MIXING (LIGHT) for Scooby & the gang



Fred's hair and Scooby's dog tag: red + green  
 Fred's ascot (scarf): a primary (not red or green)  
 Fred's shirt: the sum of all three primaries  
 Fred's pants: the primary not used to make cyan  
 Fred's shoes: the color of no light at all

Daphne's dress stripes and cuffs and Shaggy's shirt:  
 red+green+red

Daphne's dress: white - magenta

Daphne's scarf and headband: the color of visible light  
 with the shortest wavelength

Daphne's shoes: the color of visible light with the  
 highest energy

Daphne's tights: white - green

Velma's hair: white - cyan - red

Velma's sweater: red + (white - cyan)

Velma's socks and skirt: white - yellow

Shaggy's hair: green + blue + red

Shaggy's pants: white - (magenta & yellow's  
 common primary)

Scooby's fur: magenta - red + green - blue  
 Scooby's collar: the complement of red

USE **SUBTRACTIVE** MIXING (PIGMENT—specifically CMYK)  
 for Winnie the Pooh

Bell: the complement of blue

Bell clapper (the part that hits the bell): the "M" primary in CMYK

Metal bell holder: magenta + cyan + maybe a little yellow

Letters in Mr. Sanders made up of straight lines only:  
 yellow + magenta

Letters in Mr. Sanders made up of curved lines only:  
 green + red + blue (THINK!)

All other letters in Mr. Sanders:  
 the complement of magenta

"Ring Also" sign: the complement of blue

The honey pot: the complement of red

NOW USE **SUBTRACTIVE** MIXING (RYB from 1st grade art class):

Wood around the doorway: all paint primaries mixed

Bark of the log Winnie is sitting on: red + blue

Inner wood of log Winnie is sitting on: orange - red

Winnie's shirt: yellow + blue

Winnie's fur: red + yellow

Honey: the tertiary formed by orange and the complement of purple

The door: the complement of the color of Winnie's fur
